

Scrible Basics



1. To log into Scrible click the log in button then log in with your Google account (click the G)

2. Make sure you have the Scrible tool bar icon on the Chrome tool bar; if not, add it by clicking on the Tools tab and download the tool bar.



3. To create a new project, click on the Projects tab then click CREATE PROJECT. Add the name of your project and click create. This will take you to the project dashboard where you can organize your sources and create bibliographies.




